- 900K+ Veterans with Cataract




AVAO MISSION

Goal

Objective 1

Expand and enhance engagement, collaboration and communication with and between AVAO members and the broader ophthalmology community

Strategies

 - Technician training
- Create easily accessible Directory of VA Ophthalmologists
 - Location
 - Subspecialty
- Enhance collaboration between AVAO, AAO, AUPO, ARVO, and other subspecialty and state societies



Objective 2

Support VA ophthalmologists' growth and leadership development

Strategies

- Establish mentoring program to connect VA ophthalmologists with others in leadership
- Nominate AVAO members for participation in Leadership Development Programs through AAO, AUPO, ARVO and others
- Offer meetings and webinars on relevant topics for career advancement
- Provide resources for staff development and education

Goal

To promote continuous learning and skill-sharing for ophthalmologists throughout the VA

Objective 3

Create a repository of relevant resources for VA ophthalmologists

Strategies

- Create an AVAO website that is user-friendly with curated content for AVAO members
 - VA Pulse resources
 - Frequently requested directives, SOPs, and other forms & documents
- Frequently update content to ensure continued accuracy and relevance



Objective 4

Create Toolkits for VA Ophthalmologists in various career stages

Strategies

- Establish Task Forces of VA ophthalmologists to assemble toolkits
 - What every VA ophthalmologist needs to know
 - Tools for Supervisors/Chiefs/Leaders
 - Other topics as requested by membership
- Make toolkits accessible via AVAO website

ADVOCATE

Goal

To promote a VA system that enhances the career development and wellbeing of VA ophthalmologists and preserves the sight and empowers the lives of the Veterans we serve.

Objective 5

Increase awareness of issues facing VA physicians, especially ophthalmologists

Strategies

- Work closely with other professional societies to make sure:
 - ophthalmology is supported within the VA
 - VA issues are at the forefront
- Advocate for Ophthalmology physician pay to reach the same level as other surgical and procedural subspecialties



Objective 6

Ensure safe, high-quality eye care for our Veteran patients

Strategies

- Work closely with VA leadership to make sure:
 - VA policy adequately accounts for the education and training of providers
 - Patient safety and quality care is prioritized within VA
- Sponsor a trainee as Advocacy Ambassador to annual Mid Year Forum

Objective 7

Enhance the quality and efficacy of medical, graduate medical, and continuing medical education within VA

Strategies

- Work closely with AUPO to ensure the critical role of VA in physician education is recognized and supported
- Increase VA Ophthalmologist presence in AUPO leadership
